HOW TO RETUBE YOUR EARMOULD

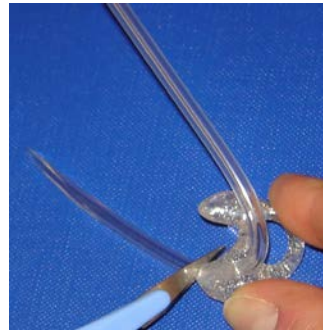

How to retube your earmould

- 1) Pull the old tubing out of the earmould.
Keep it as you will need it later.



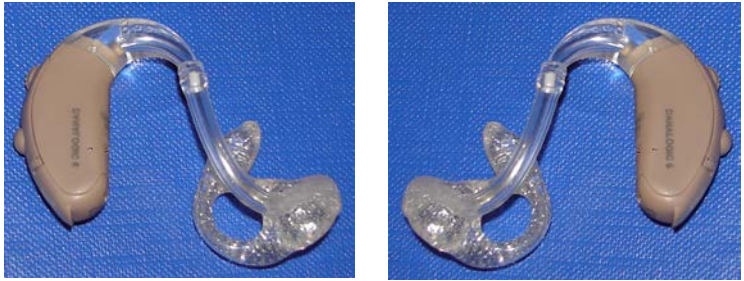
- 2) Pull the fresh tubing through your earmould until the bend reaches the point shown. Smoothly slice off the extra tubing.



- 3) Use the old piece of tubing to measure the correct length. Cut it at the point illustrated:



4) Push the earmould onto the hearing aid as illustrated:



You can also measure the tubing more accurately on the ear using our measuring instructions.
