

# How to...Grow Carrots

Peat Free Compost, Containers - can reuse pots,

Plastic Tray - with no holes in the bottom, Cardboard Tubes,  
Seeds, Water and Labels.



1 Collect your equipment - compost, seeds & containers.



2 Cut your cardboard tubes to fit into your container. Fill 3/4 with compost.



3 Take a pinch of seeds and sprinkle a couple into each tube.



4 Cover each tube with a little more compost and give them a good watering.



5 Pop the container into a plastic tray with no holes. Label your container with name & date.



6 Place container & tray on a warm windowsill. Give a little water in the tray when needed.



7 Seedlings will appear 2-3 weeks. When strong enough transfer to bigger pots



8 Spread them out - make sure your soil is stone/lump free. Place in a sunny spot.



9 Ready to harvest after 14 weeks as baby carrots or leave to grow bigger.
