Referral Process: Inclusion/Exclusion

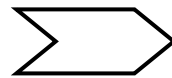
A **referral** to the Hospital at Home (H@H) service will be vetted by a **Senior Clinical Decision Maker**

Could your patient be **treated at home**?

Referrals accepted Mon to Sun – 08:00 to 18:00

Please **consider** the following groups:

- Adults with a **Clinical Frailty Scale Score >5**
- Acute Medical Illness such as **Infection, Acute Delirium, Acute Decompensation of Chronic illness** such as **Heart Failure** and **Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease**
- Acute **change** in function or a **reduction** in mobility due to illness
- **Falls** with no apparent fracture
- **Dehydration**



Referrals must be:

- Resident in **Falkirk, Stirling** and **Clackmannanshire** Council area
- Patient/Carer/Proxy **must** consent to **Home Treatment** as an alternative to admission
- Felt to be functionally **safe** at home

If the referral is accepted please send a SCI-gateway referral with attached EMIS consultations via the Acute Admission Pathway to Hospital at Home



Patients will be **considered** from:

- **Private residence**
- **Step down** from Acute hospital
- **Residential/Nursing Care Homes**
- **Intermediate Care, however** at this time we will be **unable** to facilitate care in the **SPS**

Exclusion Criteria:

- Likely acute coronary syndrome
- Acute abdomen
- Acute stroke
- Acute trauma
- Possible DVT/PE
- Head injury with loss of consciousness
- GI bleed
- Social crisis
