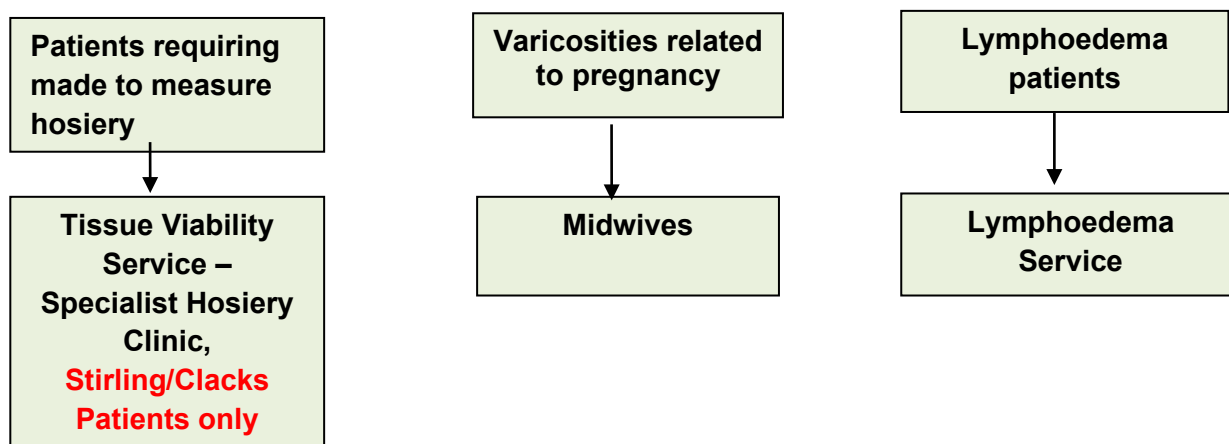


Referral Pathway for Made to Measure Hosiery Specialist Hosiery Clinic

Following Assessment and Review by Vascular, Dermatology or Out Patient clinicians, the following pathway should be followed for patients who meet the criteria set out below who require **Made to Measure Compression Hosiery**

Criteria: Large misshapen limbs or patients identified with allergies/sensitivities requiring **specialist** advice/fitting

A direct referral should be made to the appropriate service for the following patients if specialist advice and fitting is still required:

Clacks, Stirling/Stirling Rural Patients requiring made to measure hosiery should be referred to the Tissue Viability Service – Specialist Hosiery Clinic	

There is no change to the current pathway for patients requiring **off the shelf compression hosiery** from your departments. Following assessment, the patient should be measured and a product request form completed. This form should be given to the patient for them to take to their GP to obtain the product.

Any ambulant patients presenting with a wound should be directed to the Treatment Room in their area.
