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Moving to stage 3 means that NHS Forth Valley will no longer require direct formal oversight from the Scottish Government and the Assurance Board, which was established on 23rd November 2022, will be stood down. It is recognised, however, there is more to do to ensure the Board maintains and builds on the changes and improvements made over the previous two years and local staff will continue to work closely with Scottish Government colleagues to monitor progress going forward.

This important milestone could not have been reached without the support of staff and partners across Forth Valley to further improve the care and services delivered to the local people and communities we serve. The Scottish Government moved NHS Forth Valley from stage 4 to stage 3 of the NHS Scotland Support and Intervention Framework (formerly known as the NHS Scotland Performance Escalation Framework), from the 1 October 2024. This decision recognised the considerable progress that had been made to strengthen and improve leadership, culture, and governance across the organisation.

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
